TITAN WRESTLING CONTRACT

MISSION: The goal of Union Wrestling is to have our athletes attain success on the mat as well as in life. As coaches, we understand that dedication, hard work, perseverance and teamwork are the life skills that build a solid foundation for life-long success.

WRESTLER EXPECTAIONS:

- 1. EVERY practice is mandatory. Three (3) unexcused absences = removal from the team. Arrange absences at least one (1) day prior with Coach Godinho.
- 2. ABSENCE from practice the day prior to a match/tournament = ineligible to compete.
- 3. WEIGHT MANAGEMENT: Wrestlers will lose weight through hard work in the practice room and on their own. Wrestlers need to eat healthy well balanced meals and hydrate. The weight certification will determine the lowest weight a wrestler can compete.
- 4. COMPETE FOR YOUR SPOT: Wrestlers will undergo challenge matches during practices to compete for the position in which they will wrestle. Wrestlers must be within a reasonable distance of the weight class in which they wish to challenge and it must fit within their weight certification plan.
- 5. CLEANLINESS: Coaches will ensure that the wrestling room stays clean as well as do skin inspections. Every wrestler will shower after practice, matches and wear clean practice clothes every day. Look in the mirror and inspect your own skin to look for red bumps that are not normal.
- 6. LINE-UP: We will do our best to get wrestlers 27 matches throughout the season. Tournament lineups will be based upon our challenge matches. At duals Coach may alter the line-up however he sees fit to give the team the best chance to win or give younger athletes opportunities to wrestle varsity.

Wrestlers will attend every class and are expected to exceed the district minimum GPA policy. Failure to comply with the set standards will result in disciplinary action and removal from team.
